ANNUAL REPORT COMMITTEE ON EDUCATIONAL PLANNING, POLICIES, AND PROGRAMS JULY 1, 2006 — June 30, 2007

Creation, Duties and Membership

The Committee on Educational Planning, Policies, and Programs is one of four standing committees established by the Board of Governors on September 15, 1973. With the addition of Audit, there are now six standing committees. The Committee consists of nine members elected by the Board of Governors for overlapping terms of two years each. It is the duty of the Committee to receive advice and recommendations of the President and in turn make recommendations to the Board of Governors in all areas pertaining to the development of a coordinated system of higher education in North Carolina, including:

- (a) the definition of mission and assignment of functions of each constituent institution;
- (b) the review of requests for the initiation of new degree programs and recommendations for the termination of existing programs; and
- (c) the provision of supportive services, facilities, and other resources for the instructional, research and public service programs of the constituent institutions.

The Committee shall also advise and assist the President and the Board by maintaining close liaison with the State Board of Education, the Department of Community Colleges, and the private colleges and universities. It shall further recommend to the Board procedures and guidelines for the licensing of non-public educational institutions. [Code, Sec. 301C]

The Committee subsequently elected Dr. Pricilla Taylor as Chair, Mr. Ray Farris as Vice Chair, and Mr. Charles Hayes for Secretary.

The terms of Laura W. Buffaloe, William L. Burns, Charles A. Hayes, Derek Pantiel, Estelle W. Sanders, William G. Smith, and Pricilla P. Taylor, ended June 30, 2007.

In August 2007, in addition to the membership shown above the following persons were appointed to the Committee: Frank Daniels, Jr. (2009); Dudley E. Flood (2009); Ann B. Goodnight (2009); Adelaide Daniels Key (2009); Marshall B. Pitts Jr. (2008); Cody W. Grasty, ex officio, assigned by chairman (2008); Gladys Ashe Robinson (2008); and J. Bradley Wilson (2008). The committee subsequently elected Mr. Ray Farris as Chair, Mr. Philip Dixon as Vice Chair, and Ms. Gladys Robinson for Secretary.
