WHEREAS, This successful businessman, Mr. Grainger, stood tall in support of student scholarship, serving as a member of the North Carolina State University Parks Scholarship Board; and

WHEREAS, He has carried out his duties as a member of the Board of Governors with strength of conviction, providing valued leadership throughout his service on the board;
