WHEREAS, APPALACHIAN STATE UNIVERSITY, located in the heart of the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains, is the sixth largest constituent institution of the University of North Carolina, enrolling more than 14,000 students; and

WHEREAS, The ASU Mountaineer football team has always been a source of pride for the state of North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, The ASU football team has won 18 consecutive games at Kidd Brewer Stadium, dating back to the 2003 season; and

WHEREAS, The 2005 ASU team finished its regular season with a record of 8-3, winning the Southern Conference Championship; and

WHEREAS, The 2005 ASU team won four consecutive playoff games, including a 21-16 victory over the University of Northern Iowa on December 16, 2005, in Chattanooga, Tennessee to win the NCAA Division I-AA National Championship; and

WHEREAS, In 17 seasons at ASU, Coach Jerry Moore has a record of 140-67 and is the most winning coach in the Southern Conference history; and

WHEREAS, Jerry Moore has been named the American Football Coaches Association's 2005 Coach of the Year and has been invited to be an assistant coach in the Hula Bowl on Saturday, January 21, 2006;
