**WHEREAS,** This distinguished executive served Winston-Salem State University as a member of its Board of Trustees from 1978 until 1985, and as vice chairman from 1981 until 1982 and as chairman from 1983 until 1984; and the then North Carolina School of the Arts, as a member of its Board of Trustees from 1994 until 2001, and as chairman of the board from 1997 until 1999; and
