WHEREAS, This dedicated public servant began his service to the University when he was elected to the Winston-Salem State University Board of Trustees from 1985 until 1993; later serving as the Dean of the Kenan-Flagler Business School at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill from 1993 until 1997; and then as a member its Board of Trustees from 2001 until 2009; and
