

Authorization of Tuition for 2014-15

The following RESOLUTION for the 2014-15 academic year reflects the tuition increases recommended by the President after his review of campus tuition proposals. The tuition and fee policy of the Board of Governors provides a framework for the Board to use in reviewing and approving increases in tuition and fees on an annual basis. The Chancellors and their Boards of Trustees requested tuition rate increases consistent with the policy, as well as the Second Four-Year Tuition Plan. The Tuition Plan was established by the Board of Governors at its November 2010 meeting and amended at the September 2012 meeting to remove the minimum set-aside requirement for need-based financial aid.

The President has recommended that there be no tuition increases for resident undergraduates in 2014-15. The 2013 General Assembly mandated increases for nonresident undergraduates at 14 institutions (shown on page 2).

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TUITION

WHEREAS, G.S. 116-143 requires that the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina shall fix the tuition and fees, not inconsistent with the actions of the General Assembly, at the constituent institutions of the University.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that, effective with the Fall Term, 2014 the constituent institutions are authorized to charge and collect the following tuition rates.

2014-15 Tuition Rates

The President has recommended that there be no tuition increases for resident undergraduates in 2014-15. Increases for nonresident undergraduate students at 14 institutions were set by the 2013 General Assembly in accordance with the Joint Conference Committee Report. The revenue generated (\$27,243,157) through these tuition increases was offset by a corresponding reduction to each institution's appropriation. North Carolina State University and UNC Charlotte were not included in the legislative increases but NC State is requesting an increase for undergraduate nonresident students. The following table outlines the legislative increase amount and the new 2014-15 tuition rate. The proposed 2014-15 tuition amounts for all programs with percentage increases are shown on pages 11 through 15.

Eight campuses are proposing professional school tuition increases for 2014-15. Several campuses are also proposing multi-year increases. The rates require BOG approval.

NC State is requesting a tuition increase of \$750 for all students enrolled in the above programs in the Poole College of Management for 2014-15 and 2015-16. An increase of \$1,000 is also requested for 2016-17. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase proposed for resident graduate students (\$450) and nonresident graduate students (\$1,800). The revenue generated would be used for an instructional design position to enhance online learning experiences, leadership development programs and increased training in written and oral communication for all students, financial aid, and support for faculty positions to remain competitive in attracting new faculty and retaining key faculty.

NC State is requesting a \$1,600 increase in 2014-15, 2015-16, and 2016-17 for the above programs in the College of Engineering. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase proposed for resident graduate students (\$450) and nonresident graduate students (\$1,800). The revenue generated would support need-based financial aid, graduate assistantships, and merit-based fellowships in order to attract and retain the best graduate students. Funds would also cover professional development, recruitment and retention of faculty, additional graduate program staff, and the acquisition of additional equipment, software, and technical support needed for lab-based courses and online education initiatives.

UNC-Chapel Hill is requesting increases shown above for the MBA and MAC programs for 2014-15. This is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$350 proposed for all graduate students. The revenue generated would support faculty salaries, financial aid, student fellowships, and new initiatives, such as the Leadership Initiative and programming in Sustainable Enterprise, as well as partially restore program budget cuts.

These rates are all-inclusive for students enrolled in the program and cover all related expenses for the duration of the program.

UNC-Chapel Hill is requesting an increase of \$500 for all students in the Master of Social Work program for 2014-15 and 2015-16. This is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$350 proposed for all graduate students. Funds generated will support financial aid, research assistantships, recruitment and retention of faculty and staff, program and research innovations related to cutting edge research and practice initiatives, and faculty and field instructor development.

Last year, the Board of Governors approved a multi-year increase for DDS candidates that included increases for 2014-15 (see page 3). UNC-Chapel Hill is requesting an amendment to the approved rates to include an additional increase of \$500 for residents and \$1,000 for nonresidents for 2014-15. These increases are in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$350 proposed for all graduate students. The revenue would support need-based financial aid and faculty recruitment and retention to keep valued faculty members. The School's full-time faculty cohort is down 13.6% from 2008 and some clinic sessions are being canceled due to a lack of faculty members to provide coverage.

UNC-Chapel Hill requests an increase of \$850 for all students in the DNP program for 2014-15. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$350 proposed for all graduate students. The revenue generated would be used to sustain program quality and recoup some of the current costs of offering the graduate clinical programs, including clinical site placements, meeting clinical agency requirements for safety and legal compliance, maintaining a simulated learning lab, and recruiting and retaining faculty. Funds would also be used for financial aid.

UNC-Chapel Hill requests an increase of \$439 for all students in the PharmD program for 2014-15. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$350 proposed for all graduate students. The revenue generated would be used for need-based financial aid and to help fund pharmacy practice experiences. Students are required to complete 11 pharmacy practice experiences over their four years in the PharmD program, at a cost to the School of \$2,000 per experience per student.

The American Board of Medical Specialties has recently approved a new subspecialty concentrating on Clinical Informatics, which will require specialized training. UNC-Chapel Hill requests a tuition differential of \$4,000 for all students in the Professional Science Master in Biomedical and Health Informatics program for 2014-15. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$350 proposed for all graduate students. The additional revenue would go towards sustaining the PSM office at the Graduate School and for administrative costs associated with the program growth.

East Carolina University

Brody School of Medicine

\$2,000 in 2014-15

East Carolina University requests a \$2,000 tuition increase for all students in the Brody School of Medicine for 2014-15. The revenue generated would be used to support student awards and remissions and enhancements to the academic program, including funds for the creation and maintenance of virtual patient panels for all medical students, which will be utilized throughout their training to teach care for individuals and populations. Also, funds would support learning communities that are designed to create an intentional environment that fosters academic development, faculty and peer development, leadership, and collaborative learning. The establishment of a supportive learning environment is an essential component of medical education and is required by the accrediting agency for all U.S. allopathic medical schools.

School of Dental Medicine

\$713 for residents in 2014-15

East Carolina University requests a \$713 tuition increase for resident students in the School of Dental Medicine for 2014-15. The revenue generated would be used to hire additional faculty to provide more concentrated teaching support to students.

Master of Public Health

\$1,800 in 2014-15

An increase of \$1,800 is requested by East Carolina University for all students in the Master of Public Health program for 2014-15. The revenue generated would be used to support the public health curriculum through additional faculty, graduate assistantships, and financial aid. Additional faculty members are required as the enrollment in this program will increase with a transition to a new School of Public Health by 2017.

An increase of \$612 is requested by East Carolina University for all students in the Master of Social Work program for 2014-15. The revenue generated would be used to improve the quality of the program by funding curriculum innovations that bring students in contact with research and practice initiatives. Funds would also support financial aid and additional faculty and support staff to fill gaps in the course and field-education curricula.

East Carolina University is requesting an increase of \$1,800 for all students in the Post Masters of Science in Nursing program for 2014-15. The revenue generated would be used for operational expenses, such as virtual clinic development, graduate student recruitment, lab supplies and materials, clinical site placement and clinical travel. Funds would also support student financial aid and costs associated with recruiting and retaining faculty.

East Carolina University is requesting an increase of \$1,800 for all students in the Doctor of Nursing program for 2014-15. The revenue generated would be used for costs associated with recruiting and retaining faculty, as well as operational expenses and student support, such as dissertation and directed research, travel to support research, and assistantships. Funds would also be used to support merit and/or need-based student financial aid.

UNC Charlotte is requesting an increase of \$1,800 for the Master of Science in Applied Energy and Electro-Mechanical Systems in 2014-15. The additional revenue generated would support lab facilities by enabling the purchase of state-of-the-art equipment, need-based financial aid, graduate student support in the form of lab assistantships, and funds for faculty development.

UNC Charlotte is requesting an increase of \$1,800 in 2014-15 for the Doctor of Public Health Sciences. New tuition dollars would cover merit and need-based financial aid, assistantships, administrative support personnel, student collaborations with public health agencies (costs could include travel, laptops, printing), recruitment (brochures/open house events), and professional development for faculty and students.

\$1,470 in 2014-15

UNC Charlotte is requesting an increase of \$1,470 in 2014-15 for the Master of Health Administration. The revenue generated would cover an increase in the number of course offerings, merit and need-based financial aid, assistantships, administrative support and instructional support personnel, professional development activities and conference travel, enriched student services, such as enhanced orientation programs, an external speaker series, and networking events.

UNC Greensboro is requesting an increase of \$252 in 2014-15 for the Master of Arts in Communication Sciences and Disorders. The revenue generated would support need-based financial aid, personnel and administrative expenses, and equipment and supplies required to maintain this program plus partially restore program budget cuts.

UNC Greensboro is requesting an increase of \$1,278 in 2014-15 for the Master of Science in Genetic Counseling. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$100 proposed for all graduate students. The revenue generated would provide financial aid assistance, program administration, curriculum support, and faculty development plus partially restore program budget cuts. The differential tuition, if approved, would apply only to newly enrolled students for 2014-15.

School of Nursing

Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP)	\$2,000 in 2014-15

UNC Greensboro is requesting an increase of \$2,000 in 2014-15 for all students enrolled in the DNP program. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$100 proposed for all graduate students. The revenue generated would be used for faculty salaries and benefits, recurring expenses for databases, course supplies and materials, and graduate assistantships. The differential tuition, if approved, would apply only to newly enrolled students for 2014-15.

North Carolina Central UniversitySchool of Law

NC Central University is requesting increases for all students in the School of Law for 2014-15. Increases of \$683 for residents and \$1,796 for nonresidents are proposed for new students and an increase of \$441 is proposed for all returning students to strengthen and enhance the academic programs. Funds would also support infrastructure enhancements through faculty recruitment and development, curriculum improvements, bolstered operating budget, increased staffing levels in Admissions, and merit-based/need-based financial aid assistance and research/bar stipends for graduate assistants.

UNC Pembroke is requesting a \$215 increase for all MBA students in 2014-15. This is a high cost program due to personnel expenses dictated by market rates for faculty who meet program expectations and the maintenance requirements of AACSB accreditation. The revenue generated would support the cost of additional resources to support a highly qualified faculty, curriculum support, and provide financial assistance.

UNC Pembroke (continued)College of Arts and Sciences

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN)

\$215 in 2014-15

UNC Pembroke is requesting a \$215 increase for all MSN students in 2014-15. This is a high cost program due to the nature of clinical instruction and supervision, as well as intense competition for nursing faculty who are credentialed to teach at the graduate level. The revenue generated would support the cost of additional resources to support a highly qualified faculty, offset clinical costs, and provide financial assistance.

Western Carolina University is requesting an increase of \$165 for nonresident students in the Doctor of Physical Therapy program for 2014-15. This increase is in addition to the tuition rate increase of \$821 proposed for graduate nonresident students. Funds would be used for financial aid, equipment and supplies, and clinical costs.

The revenue generated would fund financial aid assistance, continued development of high quality on-line content and supplemental training materials, graduate assistantships, faculty recruitment and retention, and professional development for students and faculty.

Proposed increases for professional schools may also include the requested campus-based increase for resident and nonresident graduate students and any previously approved increases.

II. Special Tuition Rates

Nonresident Graduate Students

Consistent with the General Statutes and by authorization of the Board of Governors through a resolution passed by the Board in 1983, the campuses are authorized to charge special tuition rates for nonresident graduate students.

For nonresident graduate students that are awarded a graduate teaching or research assistantship and who are paid a stipend of at least \$2,000 per academic year, the institution may award tuition remission to reduce the nonresident tuition rate to the in-state rate. For an example, the nonresident graduate student tuition rate is proposed to increase from \$19,511 to \$21,311 at North Carolina State University. NCSU graduate nonresident students that are eligible to receive tuition remission will be charged the resident tuition rate, which is proposed to increase from \$7,173 to \$7,623 for the 2014-15 academic year.

Each campus receives a state appropriation for graduate tuition remissions and some campuses supplement this appropriation from other non-state sources. Institutions may not provide graduate tuition remissions to all students. The number of awards is limited to those that meet the criteria and the budget availability.

Effective with the Fall Term of 2014, the special tuition rates for qualifying nonresident graduates are shown on the following two pages. The new rates reflect the tuition increases proposed in Section I.

Note: The 2011 General Assembly eliminated state appropriations for nonresident undergraduate tuition waivers that had been in place since 1983 [Sec. 9.13(b) of S.L. 2011-145].

III. Tuition for Students Enrolled in Degree-Credit Distance Education Courses

Distance education students are charged on a per-credit-hour basis, rather than a “stair-step” methodology charged to regular-term students. The Distance Education per-credit-hour tuition rate is derived by dividing regular term tuition costs by 29.6 for undergraduates and 20.4 for graduate students. Since distance education students are not charged athletic, health, and student activity fees, the cost of education is considerably lower than students that are taking courses using face-to-face instruction.

It is proposed that, effective with the fall semester 2014, resident students and nonresident students taking courses within North Carolina that are enrolled in distance education courses be charged the regular-term tuition rates established in Section I. It is further proposed that tuition rates for these students be implemented on a per-credit-hour basis and that the charge per credit hour be calculated as follows:

- For undergraduate courses, the rate per student credit hour would be the annual rate divided by 29.6 hours.
- For graduate courses, the rate per student credit hour would be the annual rate divided by 20.4 hours.

It is further proposed that the Board delegate to the President the authority to set tuition rates for nonresident students taking courses outside North Carolina. These are students who primarily take courses via the Internet.

2014-15 Nonresident Tuition Increases Recommended by the Campuses

The 2013 General Assembly mandated tuition increases for nonresident undergraduates in academic year 2014-15 at most UNC campuses (see page 2). The 2014-15 Budget Priorities of the Board of Governors includes a request to remove the General Assembly increases. The campuses have requested the following rates in the event this legislation is repealed by the General Assembly.
