

**Request from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill
for Authorization to Discontinue the Master of Science in Speech and Hearing
Sciences, Speech and Language Pathology**

Introduction

The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill requests authorization to discontinue the Master of Science in Speech and Hearing Sciences, Speech and Language Pathology (CIP #51.0203) degree effective May 2008.

Rationale

This program involved a five-university consortium to provide distance based speech training. However, it is no longer an active program, nor are any students currently enrolled in the program. This discontinuation is not a substantive program change; it is intended to reflect the Division's current program offerings. The M.S. and Ph.D. programs in Speech and Hearing Sciences remain active.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Governors approve the request to discontinue the Master of Science in Speech and Hearing Sciences, Speech and Language Pathology (CIP #51.0203) effective May 2008.

**Request from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill
For Authorization to Discontinue the Master of Arts in Geological Sciences**

Introduction

The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill requests authorization to discontinue the Master of Arts in Geological Sciences (CIP #40.0601) degree effective May 2008.

Rationale

UNC-Chapel Hill currently has M.A., M.S., and Ph.D. degree programs in Geological Sciences. This discontinuation is not a substantive program change, but rather is intended to more accurately reflect the Department's current program offerings. The M.A. has not been awarded for a number of years in Geological Sciences – all of the master's degrees have been awarded as M.S. degrees.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Governors approve the request to discontinue the Master of Arts in Geological Sciences (CIP #40.0601) effective May 2008.
