SUBJECT: Inventory of Online and Offsite Academic Programs

At the November meeting of the Committee there was a request for more information about offsite academic programs. We have provided a listing of the offsite and online programs that have been authorized. All degree programs must, of course, be approved by the Board of Governors. To offer a Board approved degree program off campus or online, current policy requires approval by General Administration. We have provided a list of the authorized programs.

The programs are organized by campus. For Status, "A" indicates authorization is current, for mode of delivery the classifications are primarily "site based" or "online (Internet)." For site, the specific place it is offered is typically identified and for county, either a county in NC or an out-of-state location is identified. Site-based programs are typically at a community college or a public school. If the program is online then it may be serving residents all over the state. Online programs are also available for out-of-state students.

For a program that list a place outside of North Carolina, or the generic foreign country, an explanation of the program is provided in Section II.

Frequently the site-based program will progress a cohort of student through the program, and may stop delivery for a period of time then start another cohort. So even though the program is currently authorized it may not be active at any specific time. Some programs may be authorized but may not be implemented, for example, the program authorized for WCU for delivery in Atlanta was not initiated after further assessment.

Section I list the authorized off-site or online degree programs. Section II provides additional information about programs that are delivered at a site out-of-state. This list is not meant to capture exchange programs for short-term foreign study.

### **TransAtlantic Masters Program**

The TransAtlantic Masters Program (TAM) trains graduate students pursuing international careers in administration, diplomacy, business, policy-making, consulting, teaching, and research. Offered by way of partnerships between world-renowned universities in the United States and Europe, TAM is a unique and intensive degree program. TAM students pursue graduate study on both sides of the Atlantic while earning a master's degree. The TAM students are classified as OS students (off-campus studies) for the duration of the program. Though the students are classified in this manner, all TAM students spend one or two semesters in residence on the UNC-Chapel Hill campus engaged in coursework before they fan out across Europe to complete classes and a thesis overseas. At its outset, there was funding from the US Department of Education and the EU. The program is self-sustaining - funded with the tuition that students pay.

#### **The OneMBA Program**

The OneMBA Program draws students from across the Eastern US. Some classes meet in Chapel Hill and others in the Washington, DC area for the convenience of our students. The second year of the program entails extensive overseas travel to work with students from our partner universities in other countries. This program aims to prepare student who are well prepared to work in a global market and is funded from tuition receipts.

#### Western Carolina University

#### **Teacher Education Program Programs in Jamaica**

Consistent with the Western Carolina University Mission Statement approved by the WCU Board of Trustees in 2006 that states "Western Carolina University creates engaged learning opportunities that incorporate teaching, research and service through residential, distance education and *international experiences*..." and with the Vision Statement that states "The university aspires to prepare students to become responsible citizens in a *global community*," Western Carolina University has been offering a program since the mid 1970s leading to a four-year degree (B.S.Ed.) for over 3,000 teachers in Jamaica at the request of the Jamaican Ministry of Education.

Brief Description of Program. Western developed a program for the teachers of Jamaica, who are graduates of three-year teacher colleges in Jamaica, that builds on the knowledge and skills learned in those institutions and provides a current, SACS approved, four-year program and degree. Courses are delivered on-site by Western faculty. Textbooks and assignments are provided to students prior to on-site instruction. Face-to-face instruction typically covers two to three weeks and is complemented by student work prior to and after the face-to-face instruction. All students complete a resident semester in Cullowhee as part of the program. Student program cohorts are located in Kingston, Mandeville, and Montego Bay. Graduates of the program have attended commencement in Cullowhee and special commencements arranged in Jamaica.

As stated the program began in the mid 1970s and has continued to present times. Instructors for the program have included those from departments across campus, including Mathematics and Computer Science, English, Chemistry and Physics, and those in the College of Education and Allied Professions. Instruction has also involved adjunct instructors who often teach courses for Western and who have special expertise to contribute.

<u>Fiscal Arrangement.</u> The program is managed as a contract program and is therefore receipts based. The degree programs, long-standing B.S.Ed. and relatively new M.A.Ed in Educational Supervision, are in the College of Education and Allied Professions supported by Outreach Education.

<u>Benefits of the Program.</u> The program has provided benefits to the Jamaican educational system and its teachers. It has prepared more effective teachers, school administrators, and school guidance counselors. Teachers have been rewarded with better salaries, with greater confidence and improved skills, and with new or expanded positions.

Significant benefits also accrue to the university—to the content and quality of its academic programs, the student body, and the faculty—from its international involvement. The program provides unique international experience to faculty teaching courses in Jamaica. A professor of education wrote of his experience in Jamaica: "Although I have been back from Jamaica for only a week, it has taken me that long to sift out and process the many stimulating and enriching experiences I enjoyed. . . . I was moved both by the commitment of the teachers and the limitations under which they work daily. . . . for me, (it was) an ideal opportunity for learning through teaching and professional and personal growth. I would welcome other such opportunities."

The program has given WCU resident students an opportunity to meet people from another country and to learn about another culture from its citizens. The Jamaican teachers, visiting and working in local schools, as well as visiting churches and stores, have been ambassadors from their country, providing cross-cultural experiences for the campus and local community. In the beginning of the program, WCU resident students in teacher education had the opportunity to complete student teaching and other field experiences in Jamaica, a wonderful international experience. The opportunities ceased when the NC State Board of Education initiated more stringent controls on student teaching and Western discontinued all international student teaching. However, new interpretations and clarification are again allowing international student teaching and Western is actively pursuing international field experiences such as student teaching in a small number of countries where we have established relationships, including Jamaica. Therefore, we expect to resume the opportunity for resident students to have field experiences in Jamaica where we are actively involved in teaching courses and have many alumni who can serve as host teachers for our pre-service teachers.

Western Carolina University's on-campus enrollment has also been affected by the Jamaican program. As many as 109 Jamaican students have enrolled in Cullowhee classes during one summer. Jamaica is also well-represented among our full-time international students, pursuing baccalaureate and master's degrees in a variety of fields.

#### **Business Programs in Hong Kong and Taiwan**

We currently have a student from Charlotte in the Hong Kong program. He is a graduate of JC Smith. One of our undergraduates completed his MBA in Taiwan last year. As the programs are becoming better known, we have had an increase in inquiries from NC students. I anticipate that students who are interested in doing business in Asia will increasingly find that an MBA earned from UNC Charlotte at an overseas location has distinct advantages. The programs are taught in English and are available to military personnel or anyone who qualifies for admission. There are typically 10-15% students from countries other than Hong Kong in that program. The programs are self-supporting and a portion of the revenues are contributed to student scholarships and faculty development, especially for travel abroad. Only the salary of the Associate Dean for Professional and Global Programs is paid from state funds.

The rationale for the programs is that they build our capacity to make our students globally competitive. We view these programs as entirely consistent with UNC Tomorrow's goals. First, our faculty teach the classes at both locations. While they are abroad, they team up periodically with local faculty to conduct research and lecture at local universities, laying the groundwork for future collaborations and creating a network for our students and alumni. The experiences of these faculty members are shared with their students back on our NC campus. Second, the funds generated from these programs benefit our NC students in the form of scholarships to study abroad and support for selected requests for international projects from others on our campus. Third, they allow us to extend our UNC Charlotte and Belk College brands to Asia. We attract more highly-qualified international applicants to our Charlotte programs. Not all of our students, or perhaps, not even a majority will be able to study in Asia. By bringing talented students to our campus, we create opportunities for our NC students to learn to work with students from different cultures. We've had students from HK and Taiwan inform us that they came to Charlotte to study because they had heard of our university back home. Fourth, since we currently have about 200 graduates of our programs, we are establishing UNC Charlotte alumni chapters in each location. These chapters will interact with students in NC who need employment, networking, business partners, and insight into Asian markets. Lastly, we have recently completed construction of a videoconferencing room in the Friday building. We will use this facility to link students in our NC classes with students and business experts abroad, giving students who are unable to study abroad additional real time opportunities for international interaction. Without the experience of working in another culture, our faculty are less able to make the connections that promote and support these interactions.

### Fayetteville State University MSW Program at Fort Sam Houston

Fayetteville State University's affiliation with the U.S. Army Medical Department Center and School (AMEDD C&S) to offer the Master of Social Work (MSW) Program at Fort Sam Houston is consistent with the goals of FSU and the University of North Carolina to meet the unique needs of military personnel and to extend educational opportunities to broader audiences. FSU competed against a number of major universities and was awarded a four-year contract of \$1,049,198 in February 2008. All costs of the off-campus MSW Program are funded through the U.S. Army Contract, which include faculty salaries, staff, equipment, supplies, training and travel.

FSU's MSW Program, which is accredited by the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE), is uniquely positioned to serve the unique needs of military personnel. The U.S. Army sought a partnership with a MSW program because as the need for social workers in the Army has increased with the nation's extended commitments overseas, the number of active duty social workers has decreased. Military leaders recognize that to reduce the turnover rate of active duty social workers, they must employ individuals who have an understanding and commitment to the Army culture. Because of FSU's close proximity to Fort Bragg, Pope Air Force Base, and Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, essential aspects of military culture are embedded throughout the curriculum. All on-campus and off-campus MSW students develop an understanding of deployments, military family advocacy programs, and issue such as separation, post-traumatic stress disorders, battle mind, battle fatigue, that affect military personnel and their families. The students acquire knowledge and practice skills on how to address the latter issues. These characteristics distinguish the FSU MSW Program from other MSW Programs in the country and will serve as an asset to the U.S. Army.

The partnership between FSU and the U.S. Army enables the university to serve broader audiences and have a global impact. This partnership, fully funded by the U.S. Army, will give access to high-quality social work education to broader audiences. Students in this program will come from regions throughout the nation and world. Our FSU graduates from the off-campus program will be deployed all over the world to provide social services and serve their country. These graduates will not only provide services to soldiers, but to military families, citizen soldiers and their families. The knowledge and insights gained by serving the students at Fort Sam Houston will enrich the program's service to students in southeastern region. This professional collaborative potential for AMEDD C&S and FSU MSW Program lies in the realm of research, data exploration and publication. The off-campus faculty members have doctorates in social work and ample social work military experiences, which makes this cadre of faculty a wonderful resource for our on-campus MSW students and faculty members. The off-campus faculty members are sharing their experiences and collaborating with on-campus faculty members and students through classes, lectures, interactive video conferencing, workshops, grant-writing and research.

There are no variations in the FSU MSW degree curriculum that is offered at AMEDD C&S. The projected MSW student enrollment at the AMEDD C&S is up to twenty-five students. The minimum student enrollment is ten (10) students. The primary target audience is Army officers. Army officers will matriculate at the AMEDD C&S as single MSW cohorts. The selection of the initial cohort will include eligible active duty commissioned officers who are currently working in the Medical Service Corp in the Department of the Army. These applicants must meet the admission standards of the Department of the Army's Long-term Health

#### **Additional Items**

As indicted in the memo, WCU was authorized for an offsite program in Atlanta but did not implement the program after further assessment.
