

Authorization of New Capital Improvements Project – The University of North Carolina at Greensboro

The Board of Trustees of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro has requested authority to establish a new capital improvements project.

The project would renovate the 9,100 square-foot locker room facility on the first floor of the Health and Human Performance Building, constructed in 1950, to be used for intercollegiate athletics and academic instruction. The renovation will include reorganization of the space, replacement of interior finishes, replacement of plumbing, mechanical and electrical systems, and improvements to meet current codes and accessibility requirements. The project is estimated to cost \$3,241,000 and would be funded from student facilities receipts (available balance \$4,314,747 as of July 1).

It is recommended that the request of the Board of Trustees of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro be approved.
