Selection of a Project Designer – The University of North Carolina Center for Public Television and Delegation of Designer Selection Authority

The General Manager of the University of North Carolina Center for Public Television has solicited for design services for the Bryan Center Fire Safety System Upgrade and requests approval of the recommended firm.

On November 12, 2002, an advertisement soliciting design services was posted for this project in accordance with State Building Commission and University guidelines. Nine firms responded and a three-person selection committee interviewed five firms. The project cost is \$100,000 and the firm recommended is Stanford-White Associates of Raleigh, North Carolina.

It is recommended that this firm be approved for this project.

It is further recommended that the President or her designee be authorized to approve designer selections, consistent with the procedures established for the constituent institutions, for UNC-General Administration and its affiliated entities, the North Carolina Arboretum, the University of North Carolina Press and the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics.
