Disposition of Property - The University of North Carolina at Greensboro

The Board of Trustees of the University of North Carolina at Greensboro has requested approval of the demolition of a campus building.

The building, Park Gymnasium, is located on Spring Garden Street. The 17,051 square-foot facility was constructed in 1962 and later acquired by the university along with the Curry School. It has been used as swing space and temporary office space. The master plan calls for this site to be the home of the new Humanities Hall and Research Building, a project funded in the 2000 Higher Education Bonds, as a replacement structure for the McIver Building.

It is recommended that the request of the Board of Trustees be approved and transmitted to the Council of State for final action.
