SUBJECT: UNC Degree Program Proposals

Background: There are three proposed new bachelor's programs (3A) and five proposed new master's programs (3B). These have all been presented and discussed in a disciplinary panel and further review and discussion has taken place at General Administration.

Jurisdictional Authority: The Code 100.1, 301 C: "It [Committee on Educational Planning, Policies, and Programs] shall receive the advice and recommendations of the President and make recommendations to the Board in all areas pertaining to the development of a coordinated system of higher education in North Carolina, including...the review of requests for the initiation of new degree programs and recommendations for the termination of existing programs...."

Issues Involved: Issues specific to each program are discussed in the individual narratives.

Recommended Action: While all of these are recommended for the various actions, the individual recommendations are contained at the end of each narrative.
