SUBJECT: Reauthorization of Master's of School Administration Programs (MSA)

## Background:

Over the past year and a half all MSA programs have gone through a review process involving national, state, and local reviewers. Each programs had to do a thorough self-study and propose how their program would meet new State standards and meet the contemporary needs in North Carolina for school leaders. At the April Board meeting ten of the programs were recommended for reauthorization. The ten were recommended by the Committee and approved by the Board. Three programs needed to do further revisions, so the Board authorized the President to approve those three programs when they were ready.
