

UNC-GA and OSBM Collaborative Efficiency Review

- Identify potential shared services and efficiency measures in the following areas:
 - Residency Verification
 - Internal Audit
 - Advancement
 - E-Journals
 - Travel
 - Procurement Services



Efficiency Review Timeline





Residency Verification -Recommendation

- Establish a centralized residency classification service to:
 - Eliminate the 26% of duplicate classifications performed each year
 - Reduce the 5%–13% of inconsistently made classifications each year
 - Reduce staff burden (freeing time for other priorities)
 - Simplify and standardize process
 - Potentially serve the NC Community College System



Internal Audit – Shared Services

- Establish a centralized Shared Services Center to serve ECSU, FSU, NCCU, UNCA, UNCP, UNCSA, WCU, WSSU, NCSSM, and UNC-GA by providing:
 - Internal Audit Services
 - Continuity During Transitions
 - Career Growth Opportunities
 - Resource Allocation Flexibility
 - Work Product Standardization



Advancement – Shared Services

- Establish a Shared Service Center to provide additional capacity for the pursuit of major gifts and planned giving
- Establish preferred vendor agreements to improve service and lower costs:
 - Financial institution services
 - Education and marketing of planned giving
 - Prospect screening and rating tools
 - Direct mail services, phonathon services, and website/social media services



Other Efficiency Recommendations

E-Journals

- Share usage and pricing information between institutions to enable cost savings through better contract negotiation
- Travel
 - Reimburse authorized employee travel at the IRS business standard mileage rate to reduce reliance on more expensive state-owned vehicles

Procurement

 Expand current use of e-procurement tools, system-wide technology licensing agreements, and work with state purchasing to streamline co-sourcing regulation

Advancement	% Gift Increase	1%	2%	5%

* Cost avoidance is the inflation adjusted difference between e-journal prices and UNC e-journal expenditures.
