Request for Authorization to Consolidate
Bachelor's Degrees in Foreign Languages and Literatures

To improve efficiency and productivity, Appalachian State University is requesting consolidation of four undergraduate degree programs in Foreign Languages and Literatures.

Appalachian State University is requesting authorization to consolidate two of its Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree programs into one B.A. degree program. The following programs will be discontinued and will become specializations within the Bachelor of Arts degree in Languages, Literatures, and Cultures (CIP 16.0199).

- B.A. in French and Francophone Studies 16.0901
- B.A. in Spanish 16.0905

In addition, Appalachian State University is requesting authorization to consolidate two of its Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree programs into one B.S. degree program. The following programs will be discontinued and will become specializations within the Bachelor of Science degree in Languages, Literatures, and Cultures (CIP 13.1325).

- B.S. in French and Francophone Studies 13.1325
- B.S. in Spanish 13.1330

Students in the current programs will experience no disruption in their program of study during the transition to these merged degree programs. Individuals currently in these degree programs will be allowed to complete their degrees under the current structure.
