6. Consolidation of Foreign Languages and Literatures Bachelors Programs at North Carolina State University ......Katharine Stewart

Situation:

North Carolina State University requests authorization to consolidate five undergraduate degree programs into one "umbrella" degree program, and to discontinue the individual Foreign Languages and Literatures degree programs.

Background: In 2012, North Carolina State University, as a result of the Low Productivity Report, made the decision to consolidate all of the individual languages (French, Spanish, etc.) as well as these teacher education programs into one degree program titled Foreign Languages and Literatures under which there will be concentrations. This will allow the student much more curricular flexibility and will reduce administrative requirements.
