Situation: On March 15, 2016, the citizens of North Carolina voted in favor of the Connect

NC 2016 bond referendum.

Background: The Connect NC 2016 bond contains 21 capital improvements projects at our 17

University of North Carolina institutions, 14 new projects and seven renovation

projects that total \$1,065,000,000.

Assessment: UNC institutions are currently confirming the project academic programs and

total project cost, advertising for design teams, developing project schedules, and establishing fiscal year cash-flow requirements of their respective bond-supported capital improvements projects in preparation for the first tranche of

bond proceeds anticipated to be made available July 1, 2016.

UNC General Administration is conducting training sessions for over 100 Capital Project Coordinators, facilities operations personnel, HUB Coordinators, and budget staff at our UNC institutions to coordinate our capital project management InterScope+ platform and Primavera 6 project scheduling system.

UNCGA is also working with the Office of State Construction, Fiscal Research Division, and the Office of State Budget and Management to coordinate design and construction reviews, funding procedures, and statutory reporting

requirements for the Connect NC 2016 capital improvement projects.
