Authorization of Capital Improvements Projects – (ECU, NCSU, UNC-CH, UNCC, UNCG, & WSSU)

ISSUE OVERVIEW

UNC institutions are required to request authority from the Board of Governors to proceed with nonappropriated capital projects using available funds (non-general funds). Non-appropriated capital projects are funded by the institution, and include the construction, repair, or renovation of facilities like residence halls, dining facilities, research buildings, athletic facilities, and student health buildings.

Six UNC institutions have requested a total of twenty-five capital improvements projects: five projects for advance planning, four projects for increased authorization, and sixteen new projects for authority.
