STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETING

1. Strategic Plan Working Documents: Status Update Memorandum and Draft Goals

The first goal would focus on improving access while reducing participation gaps by increasing the enrollment of UNC's undergraduate student body, with a focus on increasing the proportion of low-income undergraduates.

The second goal would focus on increasing the number of high quality UNC trained educators, including teachers, schools' leaders, and counselors.
