AGENDA ITEM

A-3. Capital Improvements Projects – ECU, NCCU, NCSU, UNC-CH, UNCC, and WCU Will Johnson

Six UNC institutions have requested a total of 18 capital improvements projects:

four projects for advance planning, six projects for increased authorization, and

eight new projects for authority.

Background: The Board of Governors may authorize capital construction projects and

advance planning projects at UNC campuses using available funds.

Assessment: ECU, NCCU, NCSU, UNC-CH, UNCC, and WCU have requested projects that meet

the statutory requirements and it is recommended that the Board of Governors approve the projects and their methods of funding. It is further recommended that these projects be reported to the Office of State Budget and Management as non-appropriated projects do not require any additional debt or burden on

state appropriations.

Action: This item requires a vote by the Committee, with full Board vote through the

Consent Agenda.

Capital Improvements Projects –ECU, NCCU, NCSU, UNC-CH, UNCC, and WCU

ISSUE OVERVIEW

UNC institutions are required to request authority from the Board of Governors to proceed with non-appropriated capital projects using available funds (non-general funds). Non-appropriated capital projects are funded by the institution and include the construction, repair, or renovation of facilities like residence halls, dining facilities, research buildings, athletic facilities, and student health buildings.

Six UNC institutions have requested a total of 18 capital improvements projects: four projects for advance planning, six projects for increased authorization, and eight new projects for authority.
