AGENDA ITEM

Situation: G.S. 116-143 requires that the Board of Governors fix the tuition and fees, not

inconsistent with the actions of the General Assembly, at the constituent

institutions of the University of North Carolina.

Background: The 2016 General Assembly enacted a new guaranteed tuition program that

fixes tuition rates for first-time full-time resident undergraduates and new transfer students that remain continuously enrolled for eight consecutive semesters or the equivalent number of remaining semesters for transfer students. New tuition rates for 2017-18 will only apply to the cohort of students that enroll in the fall of 2017. The Board of Governors is recommending a maximum 2% tuition increase for undergraduate resident students. The General Assembly also enacted a provision that caps student fee increases

(including debt service fees) to 3% per year.

Assessment: Campuses have submitted 2017-18 tuition and fee proposals in accordance with

legislative and UNC-GA guidelines for consideration by the Board. This presentation summarizes each institution's proposal. Final action on tuition and

fees will take place in March.

"The General Assembly shall provide that the benefits of the University of North Carolina and other public institutions of higher education, as far as practicable, be extended to the people of the State free of expense."

- NC Constitution - Article IX, Section 9

"The Board shall fix the tuition and fees, not inconsistent with actions of the General Assembly, at the institutions . . . in such amount or amounts as it may deem best, taking into consideration the nature of each institution and program of study and the cost of equipment and maintenance. . . . "

- G.S. 116-143



2016 Legislative Provisions

- The General Assembly enacted a new guaranteed tuition program that fixes tuition rates for first-time full-time resident undergraduates and new transfer students that remain continuously enrolled for eight consecutive semesters or the equivalent number of remaining semesters for transfer students.
- In addition, a provision included in the adopted state budget capped student fee increases (including debt service fees) at 3% per year.



BOG/UNC System Leadership Guidelines

- A maximum 2% increase is allowed for resident undergraduate tuition for purposes of the new tuition guarantee program. This amount equals a five-year average of inflation based on the Consumer Price Index in NC (CPI-U).
 - Tuition rates approved by the Board for 2017-18 will only apply to the cohort of students that enroll in the fall of 2017.
- Combined tuition and fee rates for undergraduate residents shall continue to remain in the bottom quartile of an institution's public peers.
- Rates for nonresident undergraduate students should be market driven and campuses are expected to submit rates that reflect the full cost of providing nonresident students with a quality education.



General Fees

- Athletics
- Health Services

- Campus Security

Debt Service fees are subject to the 3% cap and are addressed by the Board when approving capital projects paid from nonappropriated sources.



Factors that Influence Fees

- Fixed cost increases (salaries, retirement, and health plan)
- Economies of scale
- Financial condition of the enterprise
- Must be used for the purpose for which the fee was authorized

Campus Security

The Campus Security fee, approved by the Board in 2015, will remain at \$30 for 2017-18. Revenues from this fee will help to improve on-campus student safety.



Indebtedness fees cover the cost of principal and interest for self-liquidating capital projects approved by the Board of Governors and the General Assembly. Fees are approved contingent upon the passage of each project in the selfliquidating bill, the authorization of the project by the Board of Governors, and the approval of the debt issuance by the Board of Governors.
