ISSUE OVERVIEW

UNC institutions are required to request authority from the Board of Governors to proceed with non-appropriated capital projects using available funds (non-general funds). Non-appropriated capital projects are funded by the institution and include the construction, repair, or renovation of facilities like residence halls, dining facilities, research buildings, athletic facilities, and student health buildings.

Eight UNC institutions have requested a total of 22 capital improvements projects: five projects for advance planning, five projects for increased authorization, and twelve new projects for authority.
