Tuition and Fee Waivers for Students from Hurricane-Stricken Areas

At the September and October meetings of the Board of Governors, the Board approved the waiver of tuition and fees for the fall semester for college and high school students that had previously been enrolled in and had already paid tuition at colleges and universities that had been forced to close because of Hurricane Katrina and were subsequently accepted to a UNC campus. Students previously enrolled in institutions that will continue to be closed during the spring semester may choose to continue their education at a North Carolina institution. Since those students have not previously paid tuition and fees for the spring semester, it is appropriate to charge the level of tuition and fees that they would have paid at their previous institution.

It is recommended that tuition and fees in excess of that which would have been charged by a student's previous institution be waived for college and high school students now accepted at an institution of The University of North Carolina for the spring semester 2006. To qualify, the student's former institution must not have reopened. In no event would tuition or fee charges for these students exceed those charged to similarly classified students at the institution.
