

Declaration of Emergency Capital Improvements Project – North Carolina Central University

The Chancellor of North Carolina Central University has informed the President of the need to invoke emergency procedures as allowed by G.S. 143-129 to provide for a new capital improvements project.

The project will repair steam leaks in lines serving McLendon-McDougald Gymnasium and Hubbard Chemistry, Lee Biology, and Robinson Science buildings. Because the leaks are producing high levels of humidity in mechanical rooms, utility tunnels, and adjacent support spaces, NCCU has invoked the procedures allowed by the statute to make the needed repairs by the quickest means possible to avoid unsafe conditions and costly damage to buildings and equipment. The project, estimated to cost \$134,000, will be funded from repair and renovation funds and Higher Education Bond funds.

In accordance with emergency procedures, the State Building Commission has been notified.
