University of North Carolina Board of Governors UNC Bond Program Report September 2006

As has traditionally been the case, there has been a flurry of activity as institutions push to complete facilities over the summer so that they will be available for students beginning with the fall semester. ASU's Smith-Wright Classroom Renovation (\$1.6M), FSU's Lyons Science and Laboratory Building Renovation and Addition (\$11.6M), UNCA's Carmichael Hall Classroom Building Renovation (\$5.2M), UNC-CH's New West Classroom Building Renovations (\$3.3M), UNCC's Graduate Engineering and Research Complex (\$22.8M), UNCG's Studio Arts Instructional Center (\$17.3M), and WSSU's Health Center Renovation (\$2.2M) will significantly improve the experiences of students at those institutions.

While contract awards are not being made at the pace of completions at this stage in the program, NCA&T has awarded its New School of Education (\$15.8M) since the last report. There are less than 38 bid packages remaining to be advertised.

In August, the Higher Education Bond Oversight Committee held its quarterly meeting at the Community College Offices in Raleigh. In addition to the customary statistical updates measuring the progress of the program, the Department of Insurance provided an update for improving plan review turnaround. Deputy Commissioner Wayne Goodwin outlined additional communications (copies of review comments to Chancellors), the appointment of a "chief expediter," the appointment of a new Deputy Commissioner for the Engineering Section, and the development of an internal checklist to support continuity of reviews. The three additional review positions recently funded by legislation had been filled and two of the three are already on site.

An updated project status overview reflecting bond program activity by institution is included with this report. A total of \$2.2B in bond funding has now been committed in the program or 88.9% of the total. Slightly more than 55% of this amount is reflected in completed projects or land acquisitions.

HUB Program Update

HUB participation, which is based on awarded contracts, is proceeding at a slower pace consistent with the number of contracts awarded and referenced above in the Bond Program update. Since the beginning of the program, \$350,000,000 has been awarded for construction to HUB contractors. This is equivalent to 16.3% of the contract awards and is comprised of 3.48% for African-American, 8.7% for Women-owned, and 4.66% for other minority contractors. The University is above the state's 10% goal and continues in its efforts to improve the percentage of participation systemwide. The following charts depict the overall summaries and specific trends in participation as requested by the Budget and Finance Committee.

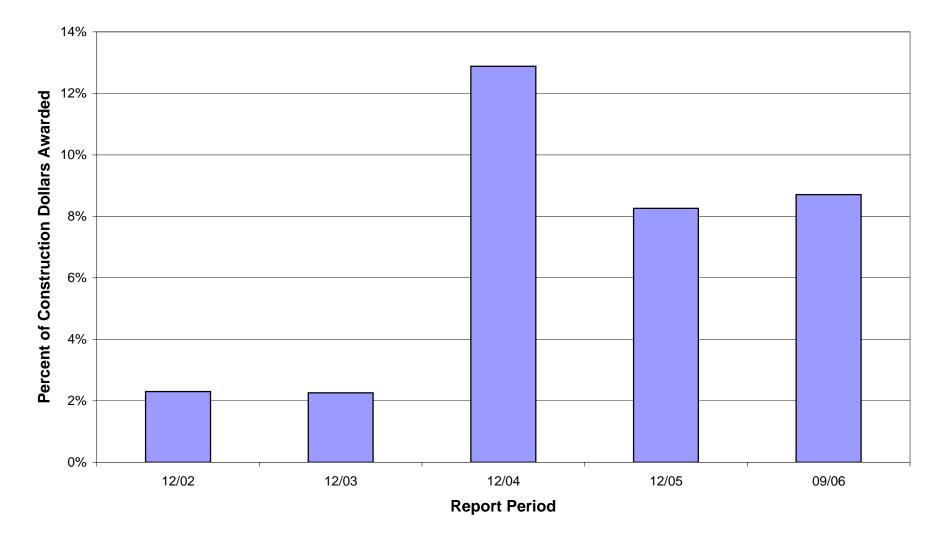
ECU African American Participation 2002 to Present



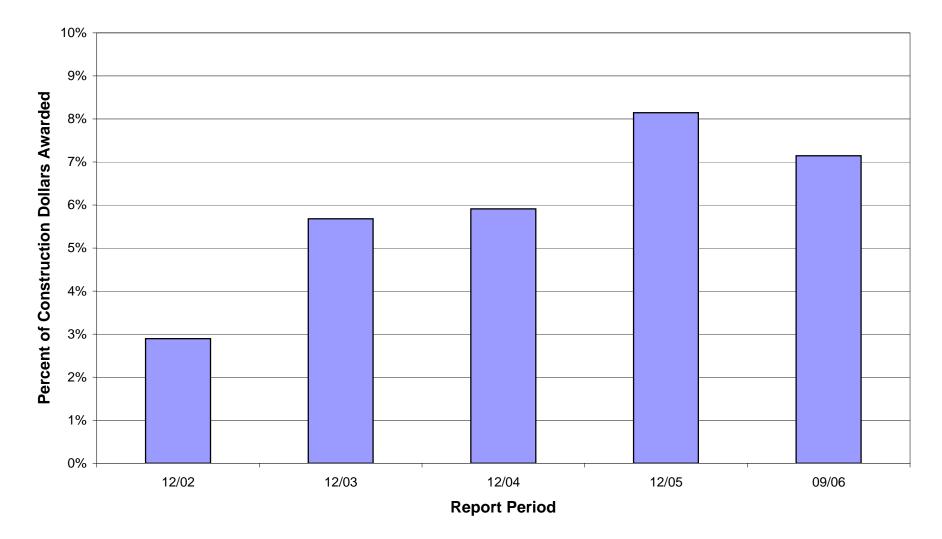
