

Disposition of Property – The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill

The Board of Trustees of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill has requested authorization to dispose of real property by demolition consistent with their master plan.

To construct the Dental Sciences Building, which will provide approximately 207,000 square feet of academic and research space, the university must demolish the Dental Office Building (15,759 square feet and constructed in 1975) and the Dental Research Building (39,881 square feet and constructed in 1967). The two structures have no historic significance. The \$864,000 needed for demolition is included in the budget of the Dental Sciences Building project. Construction is expected to begin in September 2008.

It is recommended that the request of the Board of Trustees of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill be approved and transmitted to the Council of State for final action.
