## Action Items

The President asked that the Joint Committee on College Transfer study the questions raised by Dr. Larry Blake, giving particular attention to the problem of transfer of credits from technical colleges and institutes.

If any institution feels it is imperative to get legislative approval in June for a self-liquidating capital project, it should let Mr. Joyner know immediately.

The President asked that the Chancellors take special care to see that any requests coming to the campuses from legislators or legislative staff members are promptly reported to the General Administration; this procedure has been followed in previous legislative sessions and is essential for the coordination of responses to the General Assembly.


The President reminded the Chancellors that the amendments to Section 606 of The Code, recently approved by the Board of Governors and now to be acted on by each institution, pertain to the new policy of mandatory faculty retirement at age 70, consistent with changes in federal legislation.

## Other Items Discussed
