NCLTG awards are paid to Institutions for and on behalf of eligible students each term as defined under NCLTG Regulations

^{**}The allocations above were made under the State Contractual Scholarship Fund (SCSF) program to North Carolina resident undergraduate students attending private colleges and universities in North Carolina. For 1999-2000, the allocation made to each institution was determined by multiplying the number of full-time equivalent North Carolina resident undergraduates enrolled by \$1,050. The funds so allocated were then granted by the institutions to their North Carolina undergraduate students on the basis of financial need. The General Assembly appropriated \$29,233,484 for the SCSF program for the 1999-2000 academic year. Administration of the SCSF program which was established by the North Carolina General Assembly in 1971, was transferred to the North Carolina State Education Assistance Authority in July 1993.
