Staff Accomplishments

- Staff employees have contributed to the SECC and NCA&TSU campaigns.
- The Survey has been discussed at our The Morale Survey was disseminated to senators at our October and November meetings. Senators voted to do a survey spring semester 2012 but date has been established.
