Situation: East Carolina University requests approval to change the name of the College of

Technology and Computer Sciences to the Computer of Engineering and Technology.

Background: The current name was taken in 2003 when Computer Science joined the School of

Industry and Technology to form the College of Technology and Computer Science. This occurred prior to the establishment of the undergraduate engineering degree in

2004 and the Department of Engineering in 2006.

Assessment: The College of Technology and Computer Sciences is comprised of four departments,

including Engineering, Computer Science, Technology Systems, and Construction Management. Engineering is now the largest degree program in the college.

Action: This item is for a vote.

Request for Authorization to Rename the College of Technology of Computer Sciences at East Carolina University

East Carolina University is requesting authorization to change the name of its College of Technology of Computer Sciences to the College of Engineering and Technology. The current name was taken in 2003 when Computer Science joined the School of Industry and Technology to form the College of Technology and Computer Science. This occurred prior to the establishment of the undergraduate engineering degree in 2004 and the Department of Engineering in 2006. The College is comprised of four departments, including Engineering, Computer Science, Technology Systems, and Construction Management. Engineering is now the largest degree program in the college.
