10. Disposition of Property by Easement and Right-of-Way – NCSU .......Will Johnson

Situation: The disposition of real property by easement and right-of-way was approved

by the North Carolina State University Board of Trustees and requires Board of

Governors and Council of State approval.

**Background:** North Carolina State University proposes to grant easement for new right-of-

way, permanent utility and drainage easement, and temporary construction easements to the City of Raleigh for construction involving Phase 2 of the Hillsborough Street Streetscape Project. The NCSU Board of Trustees approved

this request on September 11, 2015.

Assessment: The right-of-way and easements are located along approximately 0.5 mile of

Hillsborough Street at the intersections of Dan Allen Drive, Gardner Street, and Brooks Avenue (South) and are associated with the extension of streetscape

improvements along the north border of North Carolina State University.

**Action:** This item requires a vote.

Disposition of Property by Easement and Right-of-Way – North Carolina State University

The Board of Trustees of North Carolina State University has requested the approval of

granting right-of-ways, permanent utility and drainage easement, and temporary construction

easements to the City of Raleigh for the construction involving Phase 2 of the Hillsborough

Street Streetscape Project from NCSU as follows:

R/W Area #2: 1,457 sf

PUE Area: 867 sf

PDE Area: 358 sf

TCE Area #1: 57 sf

TCE Area #2: 4,231 sf

TCE Area #3: 12,039 sf

2. Parcel 22

PUE Area: 414 sf

TCE Area: 199 sf

3. Parcel 25

R/W Area: 2,371 sf

TCE Area: 8,737 sf

The Parcel 21, 22, and 25 properties are located at 2801, 2721, and 2711 Founders

Drive, and 2720 and 2806 Hillsborough Street. The total area of proposed easements is 25,263

SF, the estimated value of which will be determined through coordination with the NCSU

Property Office.

It is recommended that the request of the Board of Trustees be approved and

transmitted to the Council of State for final action.
