3. Faculty and Student PresentationJoe B. Whitehead **Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor**

Situation:

The Educational Planning Committee will highlight a faculty/student mentorship from North Carolina A&T State University. The student is Angelica Willis. Angelica is a Junior, computer science major, who is the first North Carolina A&T State University student to be named to the National Center for Engineering Pathways to Innovation's (Epicenter) University Innovation Fellows program. Willis is one of 150 students from 52 colleges and universities in the United States to be chosen for this national program designed to empower student leaders to increase campus engagement with innovation, entrepreneurship, creativity and design thinking. This program is operated by Epicenter, which is funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF) and directed by Stanford University and VentureWell.

Background: Several campuses have presented at the Educational Planning Committee. The topics of these presentations have been widely varied, immensely informative and wonderfully received.

Assessment: These presentations continue to reinforce the Educational Planning Committee's understanding and connection to the meaning of their work.
