William “Billy” Pizer

Billy Pizer is the president and CEO of Resources for the Future, an independent, nonprofit research institution that improves environmental, energy, and natural resources decisions through impartial economic research and policy engagement. Dr. Pizer was previously the Susan B. King Professor and Senior Associate Dean for Faculty and Research at the Sanford School of Public Policy, where he served on the faculty for 10 years. From 2008 to 2011, he was deputy assistant secretary for environment and energy at the U.S. Department of the Treasury. Dr. Pizer holds a Ph.D. and an M.A. in economics from Harvard University and a B.S. in physics from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
