

7c - Degree Program ConsolidationsCourtney Thornton

Situation: East Carolina University and UNC Greensboro request the discontinuation of several degree programs, with subsequent approval to consolidate the components of those programs into new degree programs. These recommendations are the result of the most recent biennial academic program productivity review process. No course offerings are eliminated in any case, which means students will have the option to complete their degree of matriculation as planned. The requests are as follows:
