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Situation: The Committee will ask staff to prepare a summary activity report of the

Committee's work for presentation to the Committee on Education Planning.

The final report will be delivered July 2016.

Background: Consistent with the goals outlined in the Committee Charter, the Committee's

work includes:

 Regular updates on the University's progress toward increasing military-affiliated student enrollment by 1,065 or more students between 2014 and 2018;

- Review progress associated with implementing the Policy on UNC Military Student Success, and recommend improvements to the Planning Committee;
- Recommendations to the President regarding state and federal legislative policy improvements to enable the University to achieve its enrollment growth goals established for military students;
- Promotion and acknowledgement of campus-initiated activities in support of military-affiliated students;
- Exploring access to and availability of "off-model" delivery systems for higher education to include online, hybrid, condensed and other course offerings. UNC CORE is one example of an innovative offmodel delivery system; and
- A final report to the Planning Committee on the steps required to make education easily accessible to all military-affiliated students in the State.
