## Capital Improvements Projects – ECU, NCSU, UNC-CH, UNCC, and WCU

## **ISSUE OVERVIEW**

UNC institutions are required to request authority from the Board of Governors to proceed with nonappropriated capital projects using available funds (non-general funds). Non-appropriated capital projects are funded by the institution and include the construction, repair, or renovation of facilities like residence halls, dining facilities, research buildings, athletic facilities, and student health buildings.

Five UNC institutions have requested a total of 17 capital improvements projects: four projects for advance planning, six projects for increased authorization, and seven new projects for authority.
