

MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS Committee on University Governance

January 12, 2017 University of North Carolina General Administration Center for School Leadership Development, Room 119 Chapel Hill, North Carolina

1. Call to Order and Approval of OPEN Session Minutes (Item A-1)
