2. External Affairs Division Update

The chair invited Kevin Howell to give the report of the External Affairs Division. Mr. Howell said that UNC-GA staff presented to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Capital Improvements Wednesday, October 11, 2017, and North Carolina School of Science and Math has been asked to present to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee Tuesday, November 7, 2017. Mr. Howell called upon Nate Knuffman and Will Johnson to recap the Capital Improvements meeting. Mr. Howell then invited Chancellor Todd Roberts and Brock Winslow of the North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics to share information about their upcoming presentation to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on November 7th for their western campus.

The chair invited Drew Moretz to provide an update on State Relations activities. Mr. Moretz discussed the special session in October as well as a report on the preparations for the upcoming short session. In

closing, Mr. Moretz highlighted the ongoing activities during the interim, including outreach efforts to legislators and other potential advocates.

Mr. Howell invited the committee to the UNC Veterans Summit at the Rizzo Center on Monday, November 13, 2017. Panelists include student veterans, campus leaders, along with local business leaders from Cisco, MetLife and RTI. NC Representatives John Bell, Onslow; Holly Grange, New Hanover; and John Szoka, Cumberland, will be there for a panel moderated by Jim Holmes. Other speakers include Secretary Larry Hall, NC Department of Military and Veterans Affairs; along with keynote speaker, Lieutenant General (Retired) Rick Lynch.
