DRAFT MINUTES

September 12, 2019 University of North Carolina System Office Center for School Leadership Development, Board Room Chapel Hill, North Carolina

This meeting of the Presidential Search Committee was presided over by Co-Chairs Wendy Murphy and Randy Ramsey. The following committee members, constituting a quorum, were also present: Darrell Allison, Kellie Blue, Rob Bryan, Phil Byers, and Carolyn Coward. The other Board members included Chair Smith and Adam Schmidt.

Staff members present included Tom Shanahan, Kimberly Strach, and Meredith Steadman, and others from the UNC System Office.

1. Opening Comments (Item A-1)

Co-Chair Murphy called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 12, 2019. She thanked the members for attending the inaugural meeting of the Presidential Search Committee. She called on Co-Chair Ramsey for his opening remarks.

Mr. Ramsey thanked the members for agreeing to serve on the search committee as it embarks on an important process that will determine the next leader of the UNC System. He noted that the most important job of this Board is the selection of a president. He announced that, to assist with the process, the Board had appointed Ms. Kimberly Strach as director of the Presidential Search Committee. Next, he described the role of the director and introduced Ms. Strach.

Presentation (Item A-2)

Ms. Strach spoke about some of the work that had already been performed and is ongoing. The committee had begun reaching out to its stakeholders and created a website dedicated to the search. She provided an overview of the search process and the structure that is in place for the search committee to solicit the information it needs to do its work. She described the key search tasks, including advertising the position, engaging stakeholders from various constituencies, and identifying and contacting potential candidates. She noted that balancing transparency and confidentiality is a challenge but also of critical importance, because both are priorities.

3. Adjournment (Item A-3)

In closing, Mr. Ramsey mentioned that the next step will be scheduling listening sessions, and he thanked the members for their input and feedback from the day's session.
