## ADMINISTRATIVE MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT** Revised residence/tuition Manual

**NUMBER** 49 **DATE** July 22, 1975

G. S. 116-143.1, the statute under which The University is required to classify persons by residence for tuition purposes, was substantially amended by the 1975 Session of the General Assembly and, as amended, was made effective May 29, 1975. The amended statute was summarized in Administrative Memorandum Number 47, dated June 4, 1975.

By action of the Board of Governors on July 21, 1975, the <u>Manual</u> used by the constituent institutions to implement G. S. 116-143.1 was adopted with revisions reflecting the amendments to the statute. A xerox copy of the revised <u>Manual</u> is provided herewith as prompt notice to you of the latest guidance from the Board of Governors in this matter. You will receive further, bound copies of the <u>Manual</u>, however, in some quantity as soon as printing is completed. We anticipate that these supplemental copies will be received in this office for forwarding to you in about two weeks.

With respect to the enclosed copy, I call your attention to the following significantly revised <u>Manual</u> sections: pages 9-13 (classifying and reclassifying); pages 15-16 (institutional appeals); pages 17-19 (aspects of the amended law); pages 26-27 (weighing domiciliary evidence); pages 30-35 (domicile of persons who are married); pages 36-37 (loss of domicile and grace period for married persons); pages 41-47 (cases requiring extended residentiary analysis); pages 48-51 (text of G.S. 116-143.1 as amended); pages 52-57 (changes to questionnaire); page 58 (notice to students).
