Amendment to Regulations Governing Waiver of Tuition for Certain Faculty and Staff of the Constituent Institutions of The University of North Carolina NUMBER 73

DATE November 29, 1976

By Administrative Memorandum #61, dated May 21, 1976 (effective as of May 14, 1976), regulations were promulgated from this office to implement the privilege of tuition waiver for certain faculty and staff within The University of North Carolina pursuant to G. S. 116-143, as amended, and under an authorizing resolution of the Board of Governors of May 14, 1976.

Since the issuance of Administrative Memorandum #61 it has come to my attention that there had been conflicting practices among the constituent institutions regarding extension of tuition waiver to faculty and staff of institutional ROTC programs. Upon review of this matter, it appears that extension of the tuition waiver privilege to full-time ROTC faculty and staff would be proper under G. S. 116-143. Accordingly, to provide for uniform application of the tuition waiver privilege throughout The University, I am making the following amendment, effective immediately, to paragraph 1b of Administrative Memorandum #61.

At the end of paragraph 1b, <u>delete</u> the period, <u>substitute</u> a semicolon, and <u>add</u>: "provided, that the terms 'full-time faculty member' and 'full-time staff member' shall be deemed to include personnel of the Armed Forces of the United States during the time they are assigned under military orders to an ROTC program of a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina as a permanent change of station."
