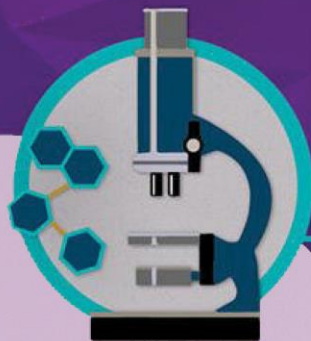

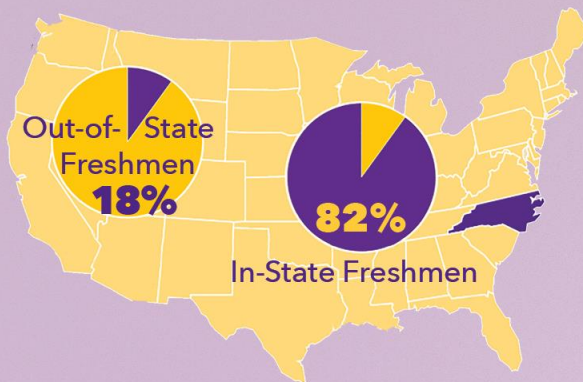

Applying to the Honors College

Application to the Honors College is by invitation only. To receive an invitation to apply to the Honors College, you must meet the following criteria:

- ▶ Submit the ECU freshman application (including transcripts) on or before the October 15 deadline.
- ▶ Have a minimum 3.7 unweighted GPA or 4.0 weighted GPA, or a qualifying test score (minimum 1330 SAT or minimum 29 ACT score) in the place of the minimum GPA

For admission, submit:

- › Application, including essay
- › \$75 application fee
- › Your official high school transcript
- › Official SAT/ACT scores (required for students with a weighted GPA less than 2.8)



APPLICATION DEADLINES

Mid-late October: Deadline to be eligible to apply to the Honors College

December 15: Deadline to be eligible to apply for other merit-based scholarships

April 1: Final freshman application deadline

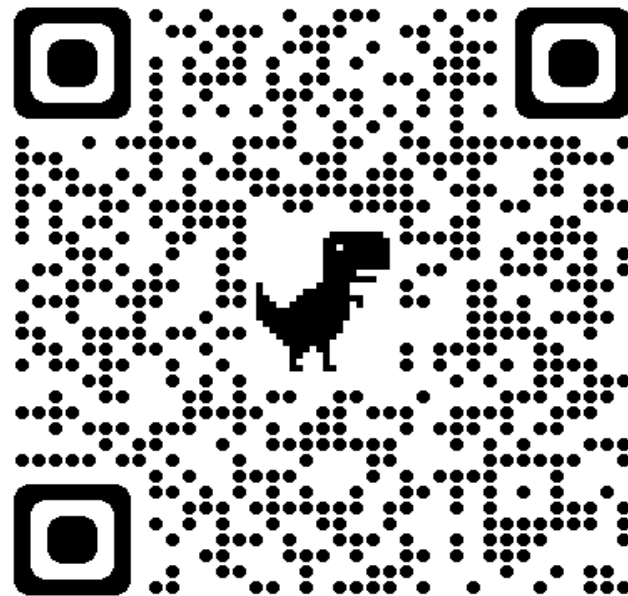

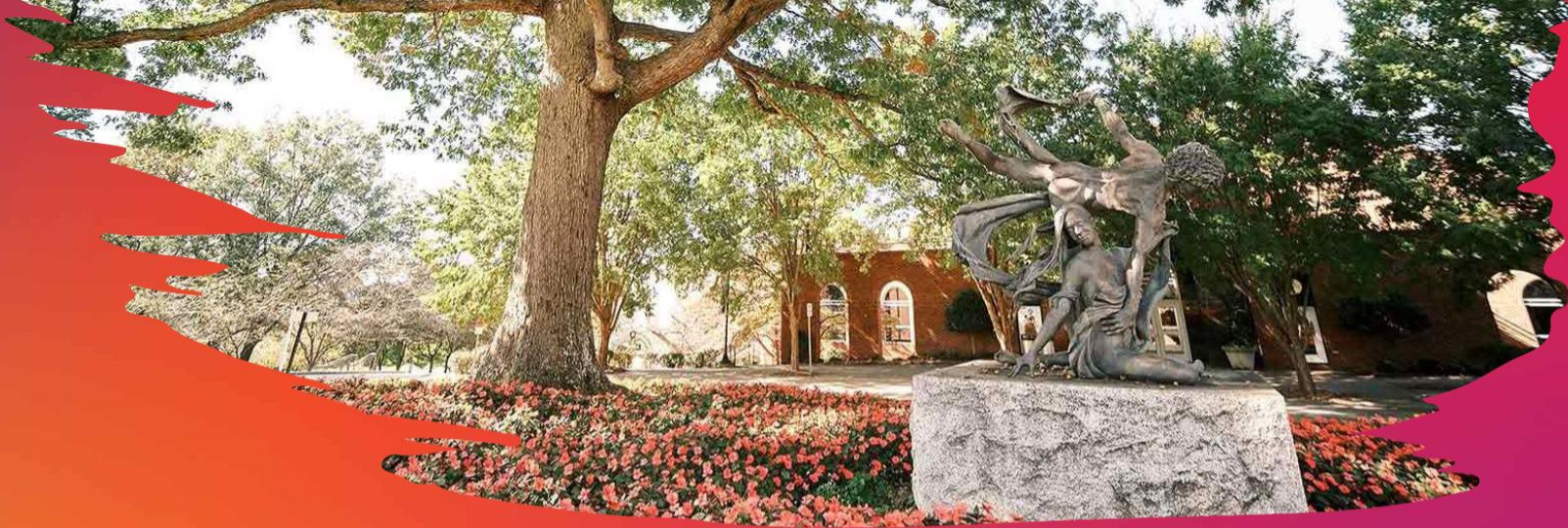
