



Applying to the Honors CollegeApplication to the Honors College is by invitation only. To receive an invitation to apply to the Honors College, you must meet the following criteria:

- Submit the ECU freshman application (including transcripts) on or before the October 15 deadline.
- Have a minimum 3.7 unweighted GPA or 4.0 weighted GPA, or a qualifying test score (minimum 1330 SAT or minimum 29 ACT score) in the place of the minimum GPA




