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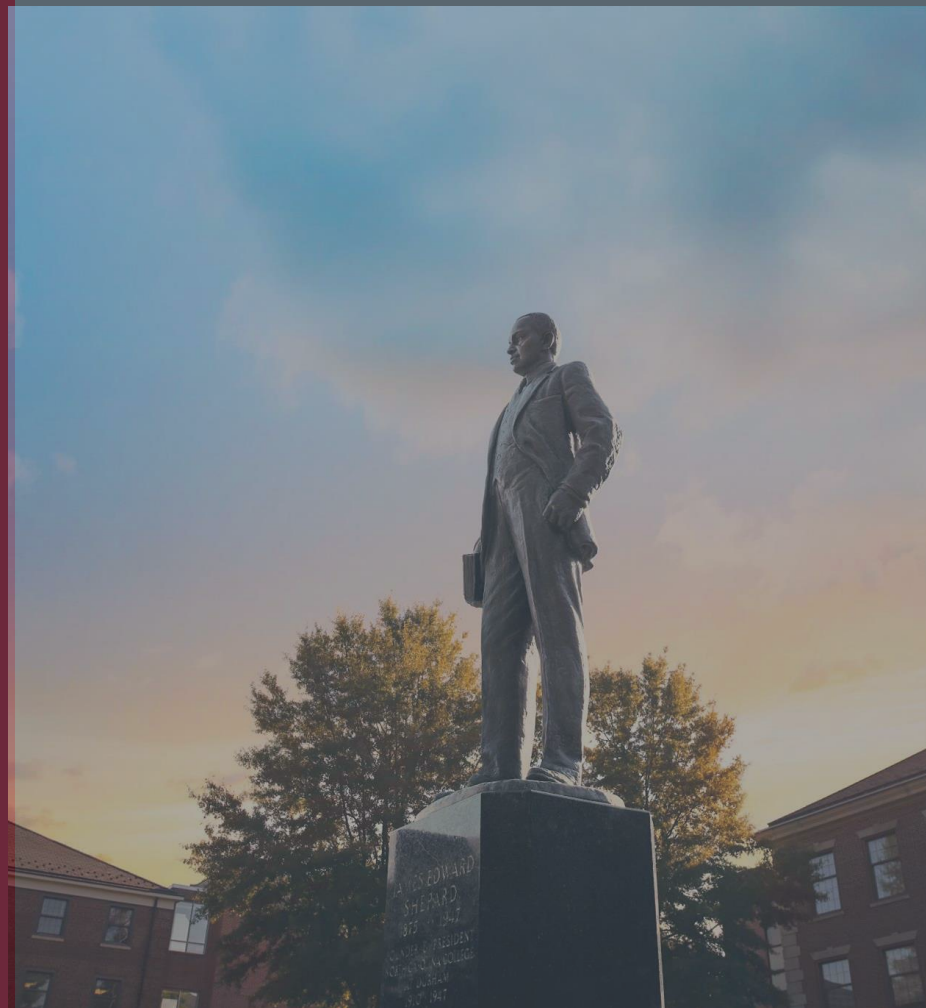


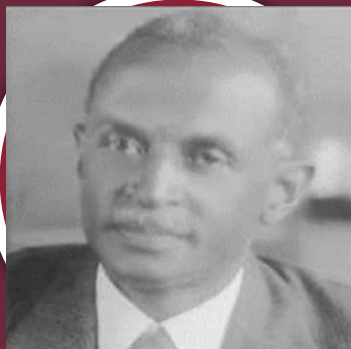

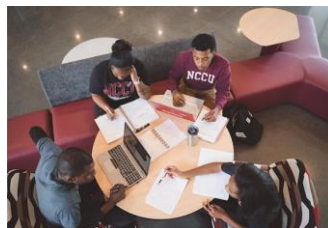

## NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY CHEATHAM-WHITE SCHOLARSHIP

The Cheatham-White Scholarship is a merit-based scholarship program for students attending North Carolina Central University and North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University. This program was designed to provide an outstanding educational experience for exceptional scholars with a wide range of interests. Students chosen for the Cheatham-White Scholarship typically are proficient in both the arts and sciences, demonstrate strong leadership potential and have a commitment to public service.

The scholarship covers full tuition costs plus fees and other expenses, including housing, meals, textbooks, a laptop, travel, plus a summer experience.

### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- Score of 1280 on SAT or 28 on ACT, and a weighted 4.0 GPA
- High school diploma
- U.S. citizenship
