



- Your College and University Courses

### **Send Supporting Materials:**

- Letter of Recommendation
- Official Transcript and School Report
- SAT or ACT Scores (optional for 2024 admission)

### **Deadlines**

First-Year Early Action
October 15

First-Year Regular Decision
January 15

**Transfer** February 15\*
