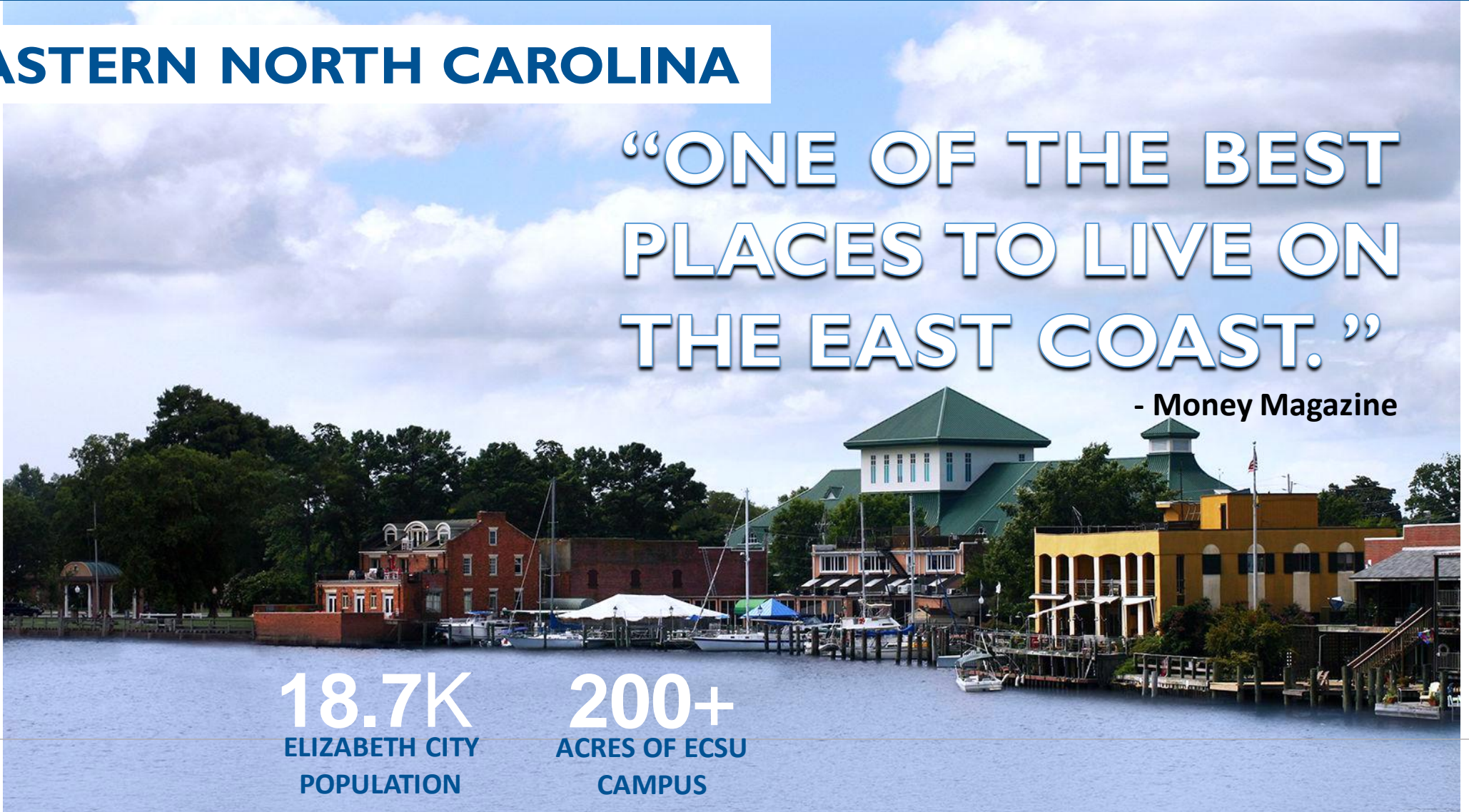

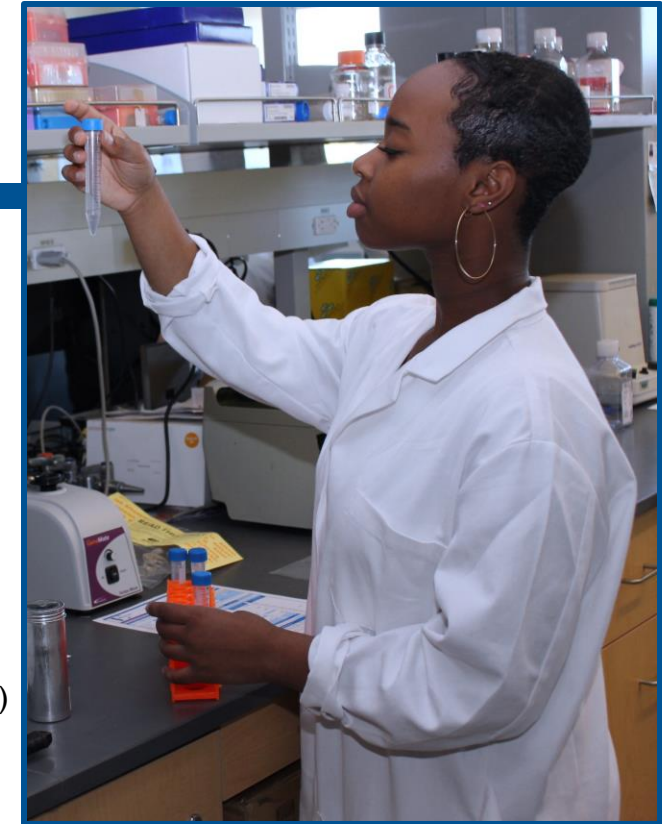

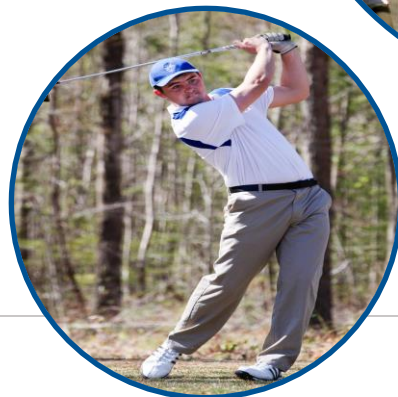

HS Minimum Course Requirements (MCR)

- 4 Units of Math (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II & Advanced Math)
- 4 Units of English
- 3 Units of Natural Sciences (Biological Science, Physical Science, and a Science with a Lab)
- 2 Units of Social Sciences (including U.S. History)
- 2 Units of Foreign Language (same)

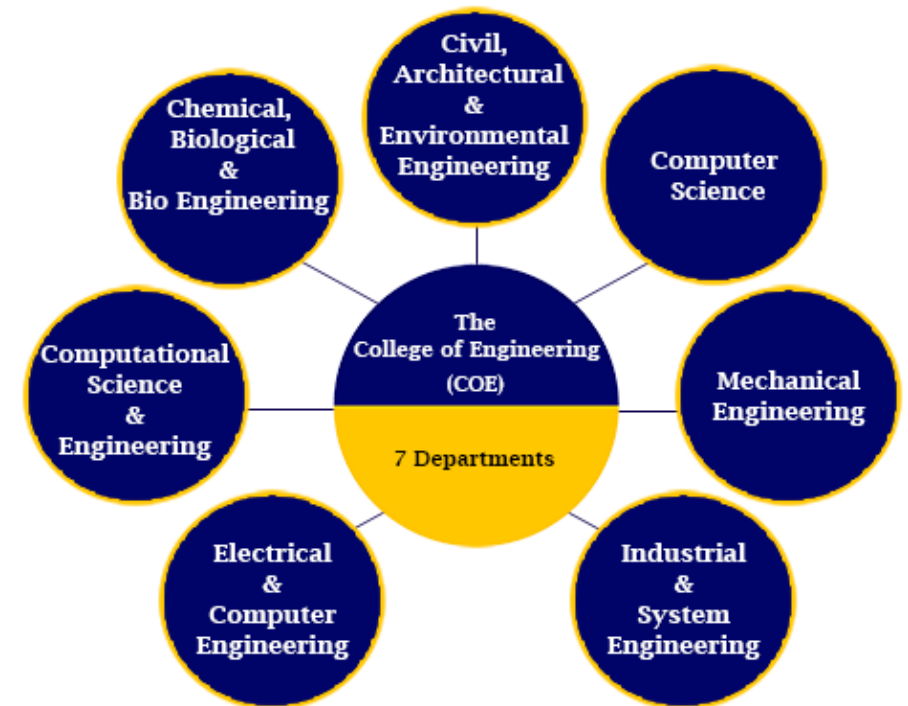

 - SAT: 1080 or higher (M & ERW)
 - Math Minimum: 520
 - ACT: 21 or higher (composite)
 - Math Minimum: 21
- Completion of Pre-Calculus



Additional Admissions Criteria

Nursing (Pre-Nursing) Students

- 3.5 or higher weighted GPA
- Test Scores (OPTIONAL)
 - SAT: 1010 or higher (*M & ERW*)
 - ACT: 20 or higher (*composite*)

2023-2024 Estimated Costs

- **In-State Tuition & Fees: \$6,734**
- **Out-of-State Tuition & Fees: \$20,244**
- **Room & Board: \$6,770**
- **Personal Expenses: \$2,400**
- **Transportation Costs: \$1,200**
- **Books & Supplies: \$1,500**

***Note:** Students can waive out of the university's health insurance.*

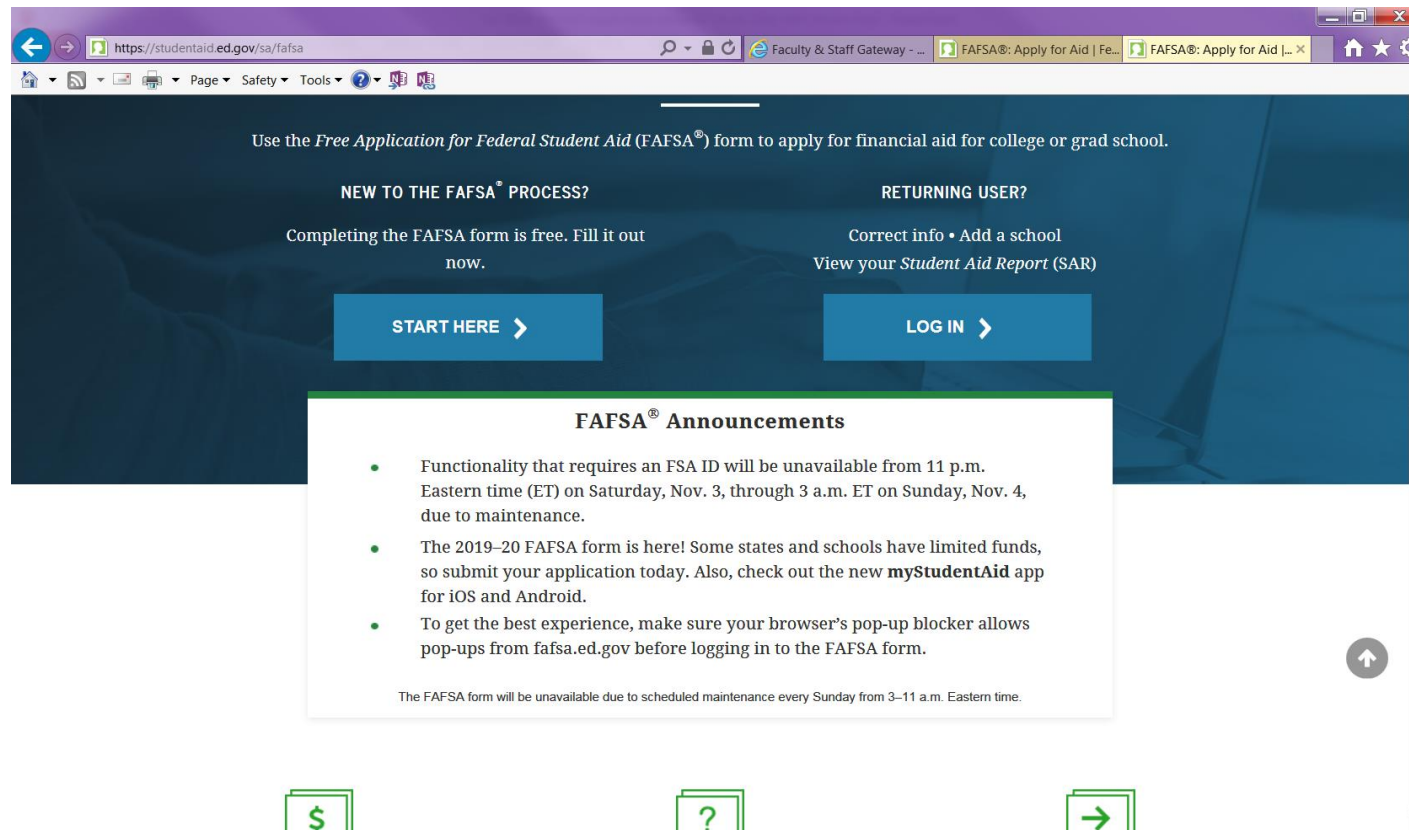

 - » **Priority Date: December 2023**

 - Fee Waivers
 - College Board, ACT, NACAC (*FR*)
 - Postal Mail or Electronic Transcript Service

Recommendation Letters or Personal Essays are optional, but encouraged.

 - Postal Mail or Electronic Transcript Service
 - New Freshmen Applicant
 - Official High School Transcript
- OPTIONAL: Official Electronic SAT and/or ACT Scores
 - Sent via the testing agency
 - SAT Code: 5003 (no optional essay)
 - ACT Code: 3060

2023 Fall Application Deadlines

- » Early Action (Scholarship Consideration) November 1st
 - » All Documents Due on November 15th
 - » Decision Notification By January 30th
- » Regular Decision: February 1st
 - » All Documents Due February 15th
 - » Decision Notification By April 1
- » Honors College & Signature Scholarship Application
 - » November 15th


